Within the next several weeks, you will receive a notice in the mail concerning your bankruptcy filing. This notice will identify the date, time and location of the meeting of creditors, at which you are required to appear to be examined under oath by the trustee assigned to your case.

At least 7 days before the date of the meeting of creditors identified in the notice described above, you <u>must</u> provide to the trustee assigned to your case a copy of your Federal income tax return for the most recent tax year ending before the date you filed your bankruptcy petition or a transcript of that tax return. The trustee's mailing address appears on the notice you will receive.

You <u>must</u> present the following information to the trustee <u>at the time of the meeting of</u> creditors:

- 1. Picture identification, such as a driver's license or passport;
- 2. Proof of your social security number, in the form of a social security card, W-2 or payroll stub;
- 3. Evidence of current income, such as your most recent pay stub;
- 4. Statements for each of your deposit or investment accounts (including checking, savings and money market accounts, mutual funds and brokerage accounts) for the time period that includes the date of filing of your bankruptcy petition; AND
- 5. Documentation of monthly expenses, if required.

If you have filed a joint case with your spouse, each of you must present the above items for review by the trustee.
